

**R.M. OF LUMSDEN NO. 189
BYLAW NO. 2025-11**

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPROPRIATION OF AN INTEREST ON LANDS:
NW 07 19 21 W2 Ext 2
NW 07 19 21 W2 Ext 1**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 deems it necessary to acquire an interest on the following lands:

NW 07 19 21 W2 Ext 2; Parcel Number 110664020
NW 07 19 21 W2 Ext 1; Parcel Number 11060981
(hereinafter collectively referred to as the "property")

for the purpose of armouring portions of the banks of the Wascana Creek to prevent further erosion and to protect municipal bridge infrastructure.

The Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 requires access to the property to complete the project, and has been unable to acquire a public utility easement by agreement with the landowner.

2. The interest shall consist of the right to the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 by its employees, servants, agents or contractors, along with their respective vehicles, machinery, supplies and equipment, to enter upon the affected property, to be finally determined by survey in accordance with section 14 of *The Municipal Expropriation Act*, for the purposes of:
 - a. municipal road reconstruction and repair, including the right to place or remove such materials as may be required for repair, reconstruction or backsloping of the public highway, including the placement, maintenance and repair of riprap, articulating concrete block and any other erosion protection materials;
 - b. removal from the land any building, structure, tree, shrub, bush, hedge, fence, soil, stones or other objects that might interfere with the rights described above; and
 - c. ingress and egress to and from the affected propertyuntil the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 surrenders or terminates the rights and privileges.
3. It shall be lawful for Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 to expropriate an interest on the said property; and to proceed in accordance with the provisions of *The Municipal Expropriation Act*.
4. This bylaw shall come into force on July 17, 2025.

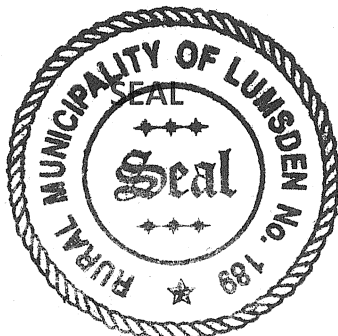
