

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189
BYLAW NO. 2022-03

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 7-2012, known as the Zoning Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189.

Pursuant to Section 29(2) and 39 of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* the RM of Lumsden No. 189 in the Province of Saskatchewan, by and with the advice and consent of the RM of Lumsden No. 189 Council, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 7-2012 as follows:

1. **Section 3.0 ADMINISTRATION** is amended by changing subsection 3.7.1(5) regarding public notice for discretionary use applications to the following:

The Development Officer will set a date for the meeting at which the application will be considered by Council and will give notice by ordinary mail to assessed owners within 750 metres of the boundary of the applicant's land, or for the following uses, to the assessed owner of each property within 1.6 kilometres (1 mile) of the proposed discretionary use:

- (a) A commercial use in a hamlet or country residential district;
- (b) Any new Intensive Livestock Operation or expansion or alteration to an Intensive Livestock Operation;
- (c) Kennels;
- (d) Wind energy conversion facilities including wind farms;
- (e) Mineral resource processing;
- (f) Gravel pits and gravel crushing operations;
- (g) Truck stops;
- (h) Auction markets
- (i) Asphalt and cement plants, and gravel yards;
- (j) Auto-wrecking yards;
- (k) Manufacturing or processing facilities;
- (l) Railway freight yards;
- (m) Sawmills, wood treatment plants and associated industries;
- (n) Trucking and transfer yards; or
- (o) Industrial complexes.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister of Government Relations.




